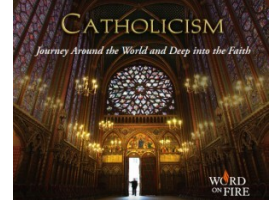




# LENT 2012 at Holy Trinity Parish

The expression **NEW EVANGELIZATION** was popularized in the encyclical of Pope Paul VI *EVANGELIZAITON IN THE MODERN WORLD* as a response to the new challenges—that the contemporary world creates for the mission of the Church.

As a response to the **NEW EVANGELIZATION** Father Robert Barron produced his project, “**CATHOLICISM**” in which he beautifully and plainly articulates who we are as Catholics and the faith that sends us forth as evangelizers.



Here at Holy Trinity, we have been involved with the **RENEW PROGRAM, WHY CATHOLIC?** and most recently **LIFTING UP YOUR HEARTS** produced by **RENEW INTERNATIONAL**. These programs have been well received by many of our parishioners.

Beginning the first week of Lent this year we will be offering “**CATHOLICISM**” as a point of sharing in small groups. There are 10 different Episodes which can be chosen by a group or individual along with questions to begin conversations on the different tracks of the episode. It will allow each group to move along at its own pace and have the opportunity of which episode you/your group wishes to view and share on. All that will be necessary is a DVD player and TV or a computer screen on which it can be viewed by your group or as an individual. The 10 Episodes from which to view are as follows:

1. Amazed and Afraid---The Revelation of God Becomes Man
2. Happy are We---The Teachings of Jesus
3. The Ineffable Mystery of God--That Than Which Nothing Greater Can Be Thought
4. Our Tainted Nature's Solitary Boast---Mary, the Mother of God
5. The Indispensable Men---Peter, Paul and the Missionary Adventure
6. A Body Both Suffering and Glorious---the Mystical Union of Christ and the Church
7. Word Made Flesh, True Bread of Heaven---The Mystery of the Liturgy and the Eucharist
8. A Vast Company of Witnesses---The Communion of Saints
9. The Fire of His Love---Prayer and the Life of the Spirit
10. World Without End---The Last Things
